Prioritization and Ranking

What are these forms being used for?

These ranking forms are being used to gather public input for the prioritization of transportation projects in each county.

What should I do with the form after I've filled it out?

There are three things you can do:

- Leave it in the provided brown envelope,
- Mail it to the Lincoln Trail ADD office,
- Bring it to the meeting at the Lincoln Trail office on April 8th.

How will these results be used?

The projects in each county will be ranked according to the results gathered from these forms. The rankings will then serve as a starting point for the Regional Transportation & Highway Safety Committee in the determination of regional project rankings.

What happens after the regional priorities are determined?

Once these priorities are approved by the Lincoln Trail Area Development District Board of Directors, the results will be sent to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Division of Planning. The Division of Planning staff will then review the statewide rankings, with regard to funding availability, and submit their recommendations for the State Highway Plan to the Transportation Secretary.

When will these projects be completed?

Generally, it will take about 10 years from the long-range planning phase at the local level to the construction phase of the project. This is dependent upon many considerations such as available funding, public needs and concerns, environmental analysis, right-of-way acquisition, and utility relocation.
