1. What is your age?

The majority of respondents were between the ages of 40-59 and 60-79, both with 38% of the responses for a combined total of 76% of the sample.

4. How do you currently travel around the area?

An overwhelming majority, 88% of the respondents chose "Drive Car" as their mode of transportation. This did not preclude them from choosing another response.

5. How many and what types of trips do you currently make per day?

About 41% of the respondents made 2-3 trips per day. Twenty-one percent of them made only 1, 19% made at least 4 trips. Of these trips, 57% were for Shopping purposes, 47% were Work-related, and 34% were Medical; again more than one option was available.

Only 13% of respondents were limited from making a trip more than 1 time per week due to the lack of available transportation.

7. Do you think public transportation should be available in the area?

Ninety-three percent of the respondents thought that public transportation should be available in the area.

The reason most people chose for why public transportation would not be used is Schedule/Availability (48%). The other top responses were Cost and Like to drive, 28% and 21% respectively.
